SID 237 News

The property tax rate for SID 237 has been reduced for the third time in five years. The owner of a \$300,000 home in Cimarron Woods will pay \$150.00 less in property taxes next year. Only 20 of the 119 SID's in Sarpy County have a lower property tax rate than Cimarron Woods.

The engineers for SID 237 have scheduled a bid letting Nov. 7 for concrete repairs to the sidewalk on Harrison St., sidewalk on 96th St., walking trails, and street panels at various locations in the neighborhood. If weather conditions permit, these repairs will take place this fall. Otherwise, they will occur next spring.
